29th UNDERWOOD CUP - RECAP & MATCH RESULTS

-Strong Singles performance propels Amateurs to 16 to 8 Win over Northern PGA Chapter Professionals -

JACKSONVILLE, FL - Five wins and one tie in the first six matches of Tuesday's Singles competition propelled the Amateur team to a 16 to 8 victory in the 29th Underwood Cup at Timuquana Country Club, their ninth win in the last ten Cup matches.

Down by just two points (7 to 5) entering Singles, the day began in promising fashion for the Professionals with six either leading or tied in their matches. But that seemed to change over a matter of only 30 minutes.

A hot back nine by Jeff Golden in the first match turned the tide for Captain Andy Purnell's amateur squad. One down through 11 holes to Oak Bridge Golf Club professional Mike Miles, Golden birdied the next three holes and closed out his opponent on No. 16, 3 and 2.

Wins by Steve Carter (2 and 1), Matt Kleinrock (2 and 1), Michael O'Neal (4 and 3) and Chris Henderson (2 and 1) would soon follow, with Devon Hopkins gaining a tie in Match No. 3.

The Cup was officially theirs when Amateur rookie Aaron Badz went dormie over Aaron Russell with four holes to play, ensuring his team would reach and pass the 12 points required to retain the Cup.

The Professionals, captained by Richie Bryant of Pablo Creek Golf Club, jumped to a 4 to 2 lead in the opening Four-Ball play on Monday morning only to see the Amateurs get wins in five of the six Foursomes matches in the afternoon and grab a 7 to 5 lead.

The Amateurs now lead the series, which pits the club professional members of the Northern Chapter of the North Florida PGA vs. North Florida's top amateurs, 15-11-3.

The matches are conducted by the Northern Chapter of the North Florida PGA and are supported by the Jacksonville Area Golf Association (JAGA) and Florida State Golf Association (FSGA). Timuquana Country Club has hosted the Underwood Cup all 29 years.

The matches have been sponsored since their inception in 1992 by Underwood Jewelers, with Clayton Bromberg of Underwood serving as the Honorary Starter and Host of the post-event luncheon and awards ceremony.

Cup partners are Underwood's, Cutter & Buck, Club Car, Chip Holcombe (Srixon, Cleveland Golf, XXIO, Bushnell) and Devant Sport Towels.
